Work: The show will take place on 3rd and 4th March. You will work behind the scene helping to put the Goulburn Show together, setting up for the show and packing away afterwards. The work will be approximately 6 hrs a day with tasks as required, mostly physical with some moderate lifting. During the show, you will be rostered for one to two hours each day to run an information stall for IVP.

Cultural activities: You will have free tickets to The Show. You will learn about agricultural issues, in particular wool growing which has an important place in the history of Australia and Goulburn. There will be a sightseeing trip (possibly to Canberra) and some time off for sightseeing/shopping around Goulburn.

Participation Fee: \$120 (AUD)

Accommodation: Camping on site at the showground. IVP will supply tents and sleeping mats. Please bring your own sleeping bag. You can make a pillow by wrapping some clothes inside a shirt or towel. There will be an indoor area for cooking and eating. The town centre is a 20 minute walk away and there you can find supermarket, post office, cinema, swimming pool.

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Arrival and departure:

Goulburn Railway Station. Nearest international airport: Sydney. Please catch the train from Central Station at 8.54am (or meet this train directly from airport) to arrive in Goulburn by 1pm. If you miss this train there is another one departing Central at 12.08 but this is more expensive. It arrives at 14.44. We will meet you at Goulburn Station and walk with you to the Showground where there will be an orientation.

The work will finish at the end of the day on Tuesday 6th March. There will follow an evaluation and a farewell party. Please don't plan to leave before 13.20 train on Wednesday 7th.

What to bring: Sun hat, closed work shoes, work gloves. It is likely to be very hot but a cold snap would not be unusual. So bring clothes for all climates, including possible rain.

Extra programme: If interested volunteers can have an extra two days at a rural property near Goulburn, Wed 6th- Fri 8th March. Extra cost: \$40.
